### Music, a Highlight of our School

Last week, Sue Lohmeyer, our Music teacher invited parents to attend her classes. **168 parents came!** All week, parents joined with their children in their music lessons... dancing, singing, answering questions, and playing instruments.







Sue Lohmeyer teaches a music literacy program to students from Preschool to Year 5. Children learn to read and write music, and have so much fun doing so, they hardly know they are learning. Sue uses the Kodaly method to teach music, and has won a reputation for excellence among her peers since teaching at

Littlehampton. Sue has presented at Level 1 Kodaly state conferences and workshops, and is well respected as a presenter and music teacher. Sue also coordinates our Senior Choir, which is tutored by Sharon Raymond, and is preparing for the Primary Schools Festival of Music concert in the Adelaide Festival Centre. She also coordinates our instrumental music program, which involves private tuition in guitar and piano, with Peter Beeby, and tuition in trumpet, trombone, clarinet, flute, saxophone and drums with Bob Size. With such excellence in classroom music, opportunities in band, instrumental tuition and choir, I'm sure parents will agree, Music is truly a highlight program for our school. The next big music event for Littlehampton students will be:
