With all the exciting new building developments, our Gymnasium still has that WOW factor, and never fails to impress.

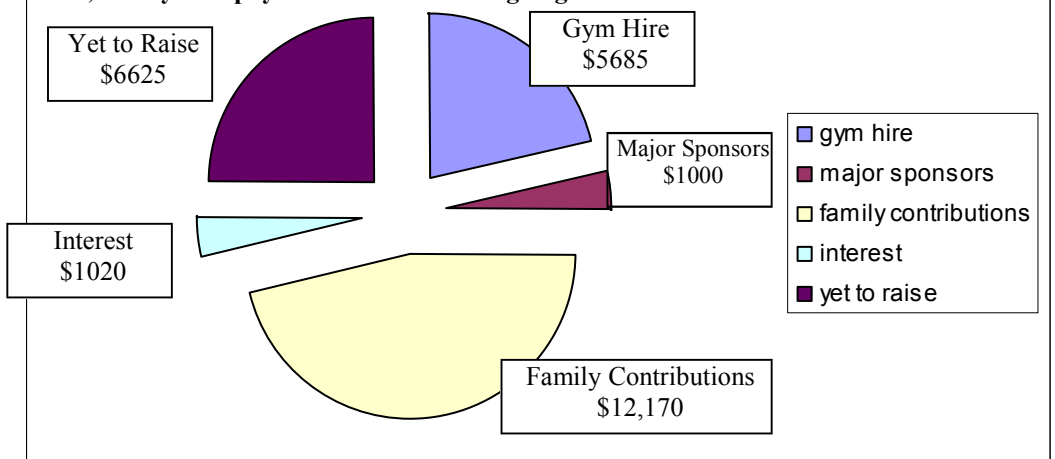

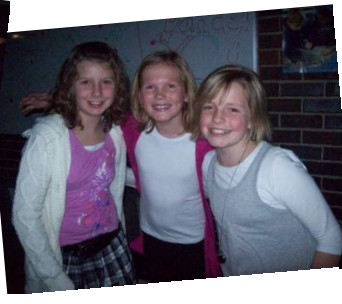
