## Spring Walk in Coppins Bush

Last Sunday saw a mixed group of folk enjoy an afternoon stroll through this important piece of remnant South Australian Blue Gum Woodland habitat. It was led by Angela Cullen (Trees for Life), with support from Noleen Sharrad (Friends of Coppins Bush) and Emma Cope (Mt Barker District Council).
Angela has been working with a team of 6/7 students to identify plant species, observe signs of fauna and create habitat for such species and reduce invasive weeds. Students have learnt that their actions can improve the area's biodiversity. Students Amber Barrow, Taehyun Elston, Tash Munn and Maeghan Evans, supported by their parents, showed their commitment to making a difference in Coppins Bush through attending and speaking about the habitat. They spoke about native vs. introduced grasses, Peramangk peoples' use of available foods, impact of pets and disturbance from neighbouring land use and maintaining biodiversity at ground level.
Many of the visitors and Friends spoke about their recollections of the Bush and were excited to learn about the great work of young environmentalists, volunteers and support groups. Mt Barker Council put on afternoon tea at Littlehampton School Kitchen with a display of information and contacts from Bushcare and Trees for Life.
