Our preschool has had additional shade area added. Did you notice? The shade area has been so well designed by our original preschool architect Sam Hosking that it looks like it has always been there.



Caterina Pennestri from SA Art Gallery visited to present a workshop with children, involving the children in sculpture of insects using imagination, drawing inspiration from pictures of insects. The children's artworks have been on display. This supported the outdoor learning inquiries which saw the children observing 50 silkworm eggs, watching them hatch and learning how they make silk for cocoons.

A vet has checked up for the animals and declared them all healthy. A special mention was made of the rabbit, who at age 8 has more than doubled the usual lifespan for this type of rabbit. More Preschool News....

Plans are well under way for the single start date in 2014. (Reminder this year there are only two start dates, Term 1 and Term 2) with children who turn 4 on or after the 1st of May 2013 waiting until next year to begin preschool . So this year, our enrolments will start to drop in Term 3, when a group of 15 children will begin at school, and no children will be starting preschool to take their place.

For the future this means:

- Less children, means less staffing dollars. Lisa Weidenbach, our valued preschool teacher will be bringing the Term 3 school starters up to the school, and will be their reception teacher. Evelyn Lam (or Jill Revilla if she is able to return) will continue as the preschool teacher for Terms 3 & 4 with some additional part time staff.
- Plans are underway at both the school and the preschool so that in 2014 we can cater for the learning needs of 5 year olds in the preschool (and from 2015, 4 year olds in the school.

Jill Revilla: Nominated for Award

Staff and parents send our continued best wishes to Jill Revilla our beloved preschool teacher of more than 18 years who is on leave while she is having medical treatment.



Jill Revilla, has been nominated for a Lifetime Achievement Award in the public teaching awards. Her nominee stated:

"Jill has been the longstanding and much loved preschool teacher at Littlehampton for over 17 years. She understands children and is able to capture children's sense of wonder, creating an inspiring and magical environment, even in the difficult facilities of the former preschool. She had a major a part in designing the excellent new preschool facility from scratch. Jill bases her learning program on children's interests and inquiries using the Reggio Emilia Philosophy. Jill has had a major influence on the other teachers and school service officers she works with over many years. Jill is recognised amongst other preschool teachers in the region for excellence in the way she works."

Positive Psychology Conference

Last year it was announced that our school had been fortunate to receive a grant to support the implementation of Positive Psychology in our school. As a result you have read newsletter articles from time to time. Earlier this year:

- 70 parents attended the meeting with Martin Seligman at Mount Barker High School in Term 1 this year.
- The report on our Middle Year Index arrived. This is the result of a Year 6/7 wellbeing survey of our students from 2012. Our students were involved in a trial of this test, which we envisage will be administered on an annual basis. A summary report will be presented to Governing Council soon, when we will plan how to share this information with the wider community.

I'm pleased to report the following events are planned:

- 6 staff will attend the positive Futures Starting Points Conference at Mount Barker High this Friday.
- We have established a Positive Psychology Professional Learning team for Littlehampton staff. 10 staff members meet regularly, read Margin Seligman's *Flourish* and other Positive Psychology books, discuss how they are implementing it in the classroom, and plan further action.
- 5 staff will attend the Positive Futures 4 day workshop at Geelong Grammar School in Victoria in Week 9 this term, with a further 4 attending in Week 10 Term 4.
- We have a small library of positive psychology books that can be borrowed by parents (when they are not being used by teachers) so if you are interested, why not visit the library and ask to borrow one.

Jill has taught the vast majority of the students in our school, and their older brothers and sisters before them. There are many parents who would love to send their best wishes to Jill.

If parents would like to send cards or flowers to Jill, to wish her the best, or remind her of some special memories in the preschool, our staff visit her every Thursday, and could take cards or flowers to her. Please drop them off in the front office on a Thursday.
